This is an application by **Udder Confusion Limited** applies for a ON Temporary Authority for premises situated at 33 Main Road Hari Hari known as "**The Rushes Café & Bar**."

An ON Licence, 56/ON/030/2025, is operative at the premises and expires on the **28 November 2027**.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence showing a takeover of the business from 11 May 2026 and there are reports from the Police and the Inspector that do not raise any matters in opposition.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order.

On that basis, the application can be dealt with by the Committee on the papers.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act, has been met.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority for **three months** to **Udder Confusion Limited** from **11 May 2026**

The conditions relating to ON LICENCE 56/ON/030/2025 shall continue to apply once the Order is issued.

A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the store is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
