THE APPLICATION

This is an application by **Mc Kien Indoy De Lara** for a manager's certificate to manage licensed premises known as **Alice May Restaurant**.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant holds the prescribed Licence Controller Qualification/s and is employed in licensed premises.

The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested their understanding of their responsibilities as a manager.

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector challenge the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the application.

However, the Inspector notes that his Work Visa permits him to only work as a chef assistant.

If tasked to be the named duty manager, the applicant must be 'front of house' managing the sale and supply and consumption of alcohol.

If that is in conflict with the permissions of his Work Visa, he must clarify that with Immigration NZ.

Subject to the above, the application can be dealt with on the papers.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfy the committee that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.222 of the Act have been met.

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by **Mc Kien Indoy De Lara** for a Manager's Certificate.

When working as the named Duty Manager, the applicant must be working front of house.

The certificate is valid for twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.
