This is an application by **Morrison Supermarkets Limited** for a Temporary Authority for premises situated at 116 Revell Street, Hokitika known as "**New World Hokitika**"

An OFF Licence, 56/OFF/054/2021, is operative at the premises and expires on the **21st of July 2024**.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence showing a sale and purchase agreement and there are now reports from the Police and MOoH with matters in opposition.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order.

On that basis, the application can be dealt with by the Committee on the papers.

DECISION & UPDATE

The application and supporting information satisfy us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act, has been met.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority for **three months** to **Morrison Supermarkets Limited** from **16 April 2024**.

The conditions relating to OFF LICENCE 56/OFF/054/2021 shall continue to apply.

The hearing date has been set for the 28th of May 2024 unless the matter is resolved by negotiation.

The Police and the MOoH are to lodge and disclose the evidence that they intend to rely on by 5.00pm on 3 May 2024.

The applicant is to respond in kind by 5.00pm on the 10th of May 2024.
