This is an application by **Thatcher & Small Limited for a second Temporary Authority for premises situated at 84 Revell Street, Hokitika to be known as "Thatcher & Small.**

An ON Licence, 56/ON/041/2025, is operative at the premises and expires on the **7th of December 2027**

The application comes about after a split of assets between the two directors of Paroa Hotel Limited and contains supporting documentary evidence showing a lease agreement in the name of the new entity.

The new ON licence application has been lodged and is undergoing enquiries.

There are reports from the Police and the Inspector that do not raise any matters in opposition.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order.

On that basis, the application can be dealt with by the Committee on the papers.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act, has been met.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority for **three months** to **Thatcher & Small Limited** from **20 January 2026**.

The conditions relating to ON LICENCE 56/ON/041/2025 shall continue to apply.
