THE APPLICATION

Kumara Racing Club Incorporated applies for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at SH 73, Kumara known as the "Kumara Race Course."

The licence is to host the annual Kumara Race Day. It is estimated that up to 6000 people will attend the event.

Substantive food and low alcohol and non-alcoholic beverages will be available at all times from various stalls and certificated managers will oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

There will be two clearly defined licensed area. One under the grandstand and the other in the Hospitality Tent.

The day and hours sought are:

Saturday 6 January 2024

10.00am to 7.00pm

THE REASONS FOR THE DECISON

The Inspector has provided a report on the application and believes the application meets the criteria for issue.

Neither the reports of the Police nor that of the Medical Officer of Health raises any **final** matters in opposition.

A comprehensive Alcohol Management Plan and a Traffic Management Plan have been prepared and signed off as appropriate for the event.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee, pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants the application by Kumara Racing Club Incorporated for an onsite Special Licence in respect of premises situated at SH 73, Kumara known as the "Kumara Race Course" subject to conditions.

Conditions:

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:

Saturday 6 January 2024

10.00am to 7.00pm;

- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol;
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with

- the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
- 5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
- 6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a) At every point-of-sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b) A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c) A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 7. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises including a courtesy van.
- 8. No BYO alcohol is permitted to be brought into the licensed areas.
- 9. Both licensed areas are designated as Supervised Areas.
- 10. The Alcohol Management Plan provided shall be followed at all times.
