This is an application by **Fat Pipi Pizza (2023) Limited** for a second Temporary Authority for premises situated at 89 Revell Street, Hokitika known as "Fat Pipi Pizzas."

An ON Licence, 56/ON/031/2022, is operative at the premises and expires on the **4 July 2025**.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence showing a sale and purchase agreement and there are reports from the Police and the Inspector that do not raise any matters in opposition.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The applicant must lodge their applications for a Planning and Building Certificate, and the substantive ON Licence, without delay!

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order.

### **DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act, has been met.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority for **three months to Fat Pipi Pizza (2023) Limited from 29 February 2024.**

**The conditions relating to ON LICENCE 56/ON/031/2022 shall continue to apply.**
