**DECISION OF THE WESTLAND DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE ON AN**

**UNCONTESTED APPLICATION**

**Authority:**

Pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and a Council resolution dated 28 November 2013, the functions, powers and duties of the Westland District Licensing Committee are delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, the Medical Officer of Health or an Inspector. There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place for the District.

**Summary of Evidence**

The complete file has been made available to me. The applicant holds a Licence Controller Qualification.

A report from the Inspector concludes that the applicant has demonstrated a good knowledge of the Sale and Supply of alcohol Act and is suitable to hold a manager's certificate.

A report from the Police has no objections to the application.

**Evaluation of Evidence**

I have considered the application on the basis of the uncontested reports received. The matter can, therefore, be dealt with on the papers.

The applicant is employed at the Heartland Hotel at Fox Glacier where he is the Night-Porter and undertakes reception and Bar duties. He was the holder of a Manager's Certificate which lapsed in 2020. He is a Samoan National and he holds a Work Visa.

The applicant has been part of the hospitality and alcohol industry for several years, and he carries some experience in the hospitality sector and I note that the references accompanying his application indicate that he is a conscientious person, reliable and consistent and is a role model for others. These are qualities that are essential for responsible management and are attributes that tell me that he is readily able to recommence the role of a Manager in the hospitality industry. I have no concerns as to the suitability of this applicant.


I am satisfied that the applicant is suitable, he does not have any recent convictions recorded against him, he has experience within the industry and he holds a recognised qualification

**Decision and Reasons**
