DECISION OF THE WESTLAND DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE ON AN UNCONTESTED APPLICATION

Authority:

Pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and a Council resolution dated 28 November 2013, the functions, powers and duties of the Westland District Licensing Committee are delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, the Medical Officer of Health or an Inspector. There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place for the District.

Summary of Evidence

The complete file has been made available to me.

A report from the Inspector concludes that the applicant has demonstrated a good knowledge of the Sale and Supply of alcohol Act and is suitable to continue to hold a manager's certificate.

A report from the Police has no objections to the application.

Evaluation of Evidence

I have considered the application on the basis of the uncontested reports received. The matter can, therefore, be dealt with on the papers. The applicant is one of the managers at the Hard Antler Bar and Restaurant at Haast.

I am satisfied that the applicant is suitable, she does not have any convictions recorded against her, she has experience within the industry and she holds a recognised qualification

Decision and Reasons

I am satisfied as to those matters provided for in s.227 of the Act.

The application is granted on the papers pursuant to s.202 (1) of the Act as Decision Number 038-2023 and I direct that renewed manager's certificate 056/CERT/038/2019 be issued to Casey May Milligan pursuant to s.64 of the Act for a period of 3 years.
