  - 1.1. The purpose of this report is to seek a Westland District Council position on the issue of identification of significant natural areas (SNAs) within Te Tai o Poutini Combined District Plan (TTPP).

Three options proposed in the report:

- Option 1 Modify Exposure Draft
- Option 2 Amend the TTPP to state that SNAs will be identified in Westland within five years of TTPP notification.
- Option 3 Maintain the approach included in the exposure draft.
