The Application

HariHari Hotel 2026 Limited applies for the grant of an OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 42 Main Road, HariHari known as the “Hari Hari Hotel.

The business is a hotel in the remote township of HariHari, and they offer accommodation, food, alcohol and other refreshments to the locals and travelling tourists.

The days and hours sought are **Monday to Sunday 12.00 noon to 10.00pm.**

These hours are within the default national maximum trading hours for OFF licensed premises.

The application was publicly notified on the council website from the 2nd of June 2026. No objections were received from members of the public.

Building and Planning certificates have been sought and issued for this activity.

Reasons for the Decision

Neither the Police (no report within the statutory timeframes) nor the Medical Officer of Health has raised any matters in opposition.

The inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the area should not be reduced by more than a minor extent.

The whole of the premises, other than the restaurant, will be designated as a Supervised Area. We do not designate gaming rooms as Restricted Area under this Act. The applicant is welcome to declare the gaming room as a Restricted Area under their responsibilities under the Gambling Act 2003.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105,106 of the Act.

I deal with the application on the papers.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** an application by **HariHari Hotel 2026 Limited the grant of the OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 42 Main Road, HariHari known as the “Hari Hari Hotel”** subject to conditions.

Conditions:

The OFF licence is subject to the conditions listed below:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:

Monday to Sunday from 12:00 noon until 10:00pm

2. No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day;
 3. While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied,
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4. The 'bottle store' is designated as a **Supervised Area**;
5. The Licensee must have available for purchase on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages;
6. A properly appointed Certificated, or Acting or Temporary, Manager must be on duty at all times, **within the licensed area**, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises;
7. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance.

The renewal will be for three years from the expiry of the current licence, and a replacement licence is to be issued.
