# Fox River Clean-up



### Fox Landfill: River Waste Removal - \$350k

Fox Rivers Clean-up Operations: 6 weeks duration in total, river and beach waste clean-up covering wages, PPE, accommodation, rations, and transport for people and waste out of the river basin

- Land covered: 21.2 Hectares covered
- Total Hours Cleaning at Site : 1172 hours worked
- Overall filled 6 fadges
- 8 employees ave. per day, weather dependent







## Fox Landfill: Waste Removal - \$1,4m

Closed Fox Glacier Landfill: the removal of waste from fox landfill and transport of waste from Fox to Butler's landfill, Hokitika. Site remediation and river rock protection wall reinstatement.

- Extraction and reinstatement plans completed for tender inclusion.
- Consent for waste removal Submission to Regional Council 12th Nov.
- Procurement process underway for tender. Documents for client review received 9th Nov. Tender process to proceed following review.
- Documents out to tenderers 16<sup>th</sup> November.
- Tender Closes on the 7<sup>th</sup> December.
- Contract physical works to start from the 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021 (subject to Council approval)

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Butlers Landfill Cell Construction - \$1.42m Butlers Landfill, Hokitika: construction of a new 1 hectare, PE-lined landfill cell for waste containment, installation of required drainage & leachate transfer system, stormwater, site haul road extension and the extension of power & pumping requirements.

- Stantec are compiling documents for the earthworks tender
- Stantec commenced new Cell design
- Soil & Rock (consultants) submitted resource consent application to Regional Council



### Cron Street extension -\$1,2m/ Cron Street footpath extension -\$300k

Cron Street seal and footpath extensions: the extension and sealing of Cron Street beyond Kamahi Crescent in Franz Josef township, including the creation of a footpath and parking bays along Cron Street between Kamahi Crescent and Cowan place

- Direct award contract to Gibb Construction
- Stantec to complete the design documents for inclusion in contract
- Start date for works 27<sup>th</sup> November 2020 and completion 10<sup>th</sup> October 2021



# Old Christchurch Road seal extension - \$3,2m

Old Christchurch road seal extension: the widening and sealing of up to 12.76km of old Christchurch Road in the Arahura/Kawhaka valley

- Tenders received within budget allocation
- Tender process complete and a recommendation to Capital and Tenders Subcommittee for approval for awarding the Design and Construct works contract
- Subject to tender approval, site mobilisation works to commence the 27<sup>th</sup> November 2020 and completion of works 30 July 2021





# Jackson Bay Wharf Repairs- \$500k(additional to \$500k already approved)

- Direct contract award to Liddell Contracting and works commenced
- Comprehensive assessment report completed for timber replacement works
- Hardwood materials ordered and delivered to Greymouth port for transport to site by end of November
- Piling rig and barge fitout being completed as purpose built for the project
- The project timeframe estimated to be 12 months including allocation of downtime due to weather impacts.





### Hokitika swimming pool renovation - \$3m

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- Design concepts have been consulted and key stake holder ٠ approvals.
- A project management company has been engaged to ٠ manage the oversight of the project and construction components.
- Further detailed work continues on planning, staged ٠ development and budget requirements, a QS is assisting with these. Building consent application to follow.
- Mechanical engineering design work is proceeding to assess Master Plan Future Proofing ٠ the internal environment needs and costings associated.
- A subject expert design and costings have been completed for ٠ the pool liner and filtration system.
