- The Upskill Project is being funded from a portion of the Provincial Growth Fund which has been allocated to focus on regional skills and employment development
- Focus on the provision of a range of different employment and training support services and support for local businesses, and people seeking long term employment opportunities
- An initiative focused on supporting people to attain recognised industry qualifications and skills -creating new and sustainable employment opportunities, keeping both people and businesses in the West Coast region
- Aim to support at least 90 people into work/promotion/skill development within companies across the West Coast over the next 2 years
- Funding allocation will be divided on a case by case basis, to meet business growth needs, with a maximum of \$10,000 of training investment per person

- Skills/Training needs are identified
- Training plan put in place supported by and paid for by Upskill Project

Employers/Business Criteria:


- Business must be in a stable position, able to sustain any offer/s of employment or position advancement opportunities
