Official information request for information on notices to fix, consents issued and complaints to Westland District Council for two tiny homes on [REFERED TO AN INDIVIDAL'S PROPERTY].

I refer to your official information request dated 08 October 2019 and subsequent clarification on 24 October 2019 to know if Council has issued notices to fix on the two tiny homes at **[REFERED TO AN INDIVIDAL'S PROPERTY]**. Has the Council already issued any kind of consents for the tiny homes and details of any consents issued to date, including any notices to fix and complaints to the council about the homes (if any).

[REFERED TO AN INDIVIDAL'S PROPERTY]

Council considers both "structures" to be buildings under the Act (based on determinations used from MBIE and discussion with other councils NZ wide) and if these buildings consents were applied for now, they would be treated as under the new policy for "when is a structure a vehicle or a building". However, due to information provided at the time of consent, and the implementation of the policy was not until June 2019, they cannot be included in the policy, **[REFERED TO AN INDIVIDAL'S PROPERTY]**.
