

Annual report on income and costs related to Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012
Year ending 30 June 2016
Westland District Council

Background

Section 19 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013 requires an annual report on income and expenditure for a Council's activities under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 ("the Act"). Section 19 reads as follows:

19 Reporting by territorial authorities

- (1) Every territorial authority must, each year, prepare and make publicly available a report showing its income from fees payable in relation to, and its costs incurred in,—
 - (a) the performance of the functions of its licensing committee under the Act; and
 - (b) the performance of the functions of its inspectors under the Act; and
 - (c) undertaking enforcement activities under the Act.
- (2) The first report required by this regulation must relate to the year commencing 1 July 2014.

All figures in this report are exclusive of GST and relate to the financial year 2015/16; that is, 1 July 2015 through 30 June 2016. Revenue figures are per monthly reports to the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority (ARLA), and expenditure figures are from the Council's electronic financial software.

Income

The Westland District Council received \$97,385 in revenue from fees payable in relation to its activities under the Act. This figure is net of the \$8,095 in revenue that was required to be passed on to ARLA.

Costs

The Westland District Council incurred costs of \$74,779 in performing its activities under the Act. Costs were incurred in the following categories:

Net Surplus

The Westland District Council had a net surplus of \$22,606 from its activities under the Act. This was used to offset the cost of other Council activities for 2015/16.
