# Capital Projects – Transport (footpaths & drainage)

- Footpath upgrades presently being worked on and planned:
  - Kaniere School to new crossing, estimate d at \$ 25,000
  - Airport Drive footpath extension, estimated at \$ 25,000
  - Cron Street upgrade (applied for funding through shovel ready projects)
  - Park Street and Hampden Street (repairs to existing settled slabs), awaiting costs
  - Whataroa (chip-sealing one side of Wilson, Murray & Robert Streets), estimated at \$6,500
- Drainage Renewals and Footpath works presently in progress:
  - Dorothy Falls and Waiho Flat Road following major damage in 2019
- Footpath works completed this year:
  - Sewell Street and Hamilton Street concrete replacement and crossing upgrades totalling \$ 48,000

Note: Drainage upgrades also include Kerb and Channel repairs and some of the areas having footpaths fixed will likely also require a level of kerb replacement
