# <u>DECISION OF THE WESTLAND DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE ON AN</u>

## UNCONTESTED APPLICATION

### **AUTHORITY:**

Pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) and a Council resolution dated 28 November 2013, the functions, powers and duties of the Westland District Licensing Committee are delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, the Medical Officer of Health or an Inspector. There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place for the District.

## Summary of Evidence

The Police advise that there is no objection to the application.

# Decision and Reasons

I am satisfied as to those matters provided for in s.227 of the Act, I am satisfied that the applicant is suitable, she does not have any convictions recorded against her, she has experience within the industry, and she holds a recognised qualification.

The application is granted on the papers pursuant to s.202(1) of the Act as Decision Number **078-2020** and I direct that renewed manager's certificate 56/CERT/067/2019 be issued to Emily Suzanne Long pursuant to s.64 of the Act.

The renewal is on the existing terms and conditions for a period of three years from the date of expiry.
