**DECISION OF THE WESTLAND DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE ON AN UNCONTESTED  
APPLICATION**

**Authority:**

Pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) and a Council resolution dated 28 November 2013, the functions, powers and duties of the Westland District Licensing Committee are delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, the Medical Officer of Health or an Inspector. There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place for the District.

**Summary of Evidence**

The complete file has been made available to me.

A comprehensive report from the Inspector concludes that the applicant is suitable to continue to hold a licence.

The Police advise that there are no objections to the renewal application.

The Medical Officer of Health has no opposition to the renewal application.

**Evaluation of Evidence**

I have considered the application on the basis of the uncontested reports received. The matter is able to be dealt with on the papers.

I am satisfied as to those matters provided for in s.131 of the Act.

No changes to the existing terms and conditions are proposed and the opening days and hours will remain as Monday to Sunday from 9:00am to 11:00pm.

The bar area has been designated as a supervised area between 9am and 10pm, and the entire premises is to be restricted from 10pm until 1:30 am the following day.

The applicant is a private company and the two Directors are Nicholas Robert Paul Kummer and Simon Calder Banks who are both actively involved in the business.

I am satisfied that there is no requirement for any designations.

**Decision and Reasons**

I am satisfied as to those matters provided for in s.131 of the Act.

The application is granted on the papers pursuant to s.202 (1) of the Act as Decision Number **110-2019** and I direct that renewed licence 56/OFF/026/2015 be issued to HAB 2013 Limited pursuant to s.64 of the Act.

The renewal is for a period of three years from the date of expiry and is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday from 9:00AM to 11.00PM the same day

Except when the licensee also holds a special licence for the premises no alcohol is to be sold or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day to any person.

- (b) The principal Entrance is to be designated as the entrance from Marks Road  
(c) The Licensee is to continue to have a Host Responsibility Policy specific to the premises.
