**DECISION OF THE WESTLAND DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE ON AN
UNCONTESTED APPLICATION**

AUTHORITY:

Pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and a Council resolution dated 28 November 2013, the functions, powers and duties of the Westland District Licensing Committee are delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, the Medical Officer of Health or an Inspector. There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place for the District.

Summary of Evidence

The complete file has been made available to me.

A report from the Inspector concludes that the applicant is suitable to continue to hold a manager's certificate.

The Police advise that there is no objection to the application.

Evaluation of Evidence

I have considered the application on the basis of the uncontested reports received. The matter is able to be dealt with on the papers.

I do note that there is a conviction for assault from 2013. There was no penalty imposed and I am not of the opinion that the matter requires any particular consideration with regard to this application; I accept that it is historic and lacks particular relevance now.


Decision and Reasons

I am satisfied as to those matters provided for in s.227 of the Act, I am satisfied that the applicant is suitable, although he does have a conviction recorded against him I accept that its relevance at this time is not great, he has experience within the industry, and he holds a recognised qualification.

The application is granted on the papers pursuant to s.202 (1) of the Act as Decision Number **116-2020** and I direct that renewed manager's certificate 56/CERT/080/2019 be issued to Garry Alan Calteaux pursuant to s.64 of the Act.

The renewal is on the existing terms and conditions for a period of three years from the date of expiry.
