DECISION OF THE WESTLAND DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE ON AN UNCONTESTED APPLICATION

Authority:

Pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and a Council resolution dated 28 November 2013, the functions, powers and duties of the Westland District Licensing Committee are delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, the Medical Officer of Health or an Inspector. There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place for the District.

Summary of Evidence

The complete file has been made available to me.

A report from the Inspector concludes that the applicant is suitable to hold a manager's certificate.

The Police did not report on the application.

Evaluation of Evidence

I have considered the application on the basis of the uncontested reports received. The matter can, therefore, be dealt with on the papers.

The surprising aspect of this application is that it has been made now. I would have presumed that Leanne was in possession of a Manager's Certificate from some years ago as she has always been at the front end of the various businesses that she has been associated with. I have observed Leanne operating in the several businesses that she has been a party to and I have no doubt that her leadership within the hospitality industry will be of benefit to the industry as a whole.

I am satisfied that the applicant is suitable, she does not have any convictions recorded against her, she has many years of experience within the industry and she holds a recognised qualification

Decision and Reasons

I am satisfied as to those matters provided for in s.222 of the Act.

The application is granted on the papers pursuant to s.202 (1) of the Act as Decision Number 170-2019 and I direct that a certificate be issued to Leanne Michelle Cutler pursuant to s.64 of the Act for a period of 12 months.
