### NOTES (any reference to "the Act" means the Local Electoral Act 2001)

If the election is for a subdivision of a local government area (ward, constituency or community/local board subdivision), **the nominators must be electors of that subdivision**. If under any enactment a candidate is not qualified for election unless he/she is an elector of the subdivision, then the nominee must also be an elector of that subdivision.

A nominator in the case of a candidate for city, district and regional council or a community/local board may be **residential** or **ratepayer elector**.

## A candidate may not nominate him/herself for office.

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Under Section 21 of the Act, any person is liable to a fine of \$2,000 who:

- (a) consents to being nominated as a candidate when knowing him/herself to be ineligible for election; or
- (b) nominates any person as a candidate whom he/she knows to be ineligible; or
- (c) not being a candidate, signs any nomination paper knowing that he/she is not qualified to vote at the election.

Evidence of New Zealand citizenship may be requested by the electoral officer at time of candidate nomination. Acceptable evidence includes a NZ Passport, NZ Birth Certificate, or NZ Citizenship documentation.

Section 58 of the Act prohibits any person from being a candidate for a regional council and a candidate for any constituent authority within that region, i.e. no person can stand for the West Coast Regional Council and the Westland District Council.

Where no affiliation is claimed, or an affiliation is disallowed by the Electoral Officer under *Section 57 of the Act*, nothing will be shown in the public notice against the candidate's name, whether or not any other candidates have claimed an affiliation. You may identify yourself as an "independent candidate", i.e. "Independent".

A candidate may, under *Section 56 of the Act*, be nominated under a name by which the candidate is commonly known, provided the name will not:

- cause offence to a reasonable person
- be unreasonably long
- include or resemble an official title or rank
- cause confusion or mislead electors.

A candidate may, in accordance with Section 61 of the Act and Regulations 26-29 of the Local Electoral
Regulations 2001, provide a candidate profile statement including a recent photograph for dispatch to the electors with the voting documents. These must be lodged with the nomination form and deposit.

#### SOME TIPS REGARDING THE NOMINATION and THE CANDIDATE PROFILE STATEMENT

#### PLEASE ALSO READ THE NOTES ON THE NOMINATION PAPER and THE CANDIDATE INFORMATION BOOKLET

#### NOMINATION

- Any person who is a New Zealand citizen, and enrolled on any New Zealand parliamentary electoral roll can be a candidate for any position.
- The two nominators must be enrolled and be able to vote in the election for which the candidate is standing.
- There are some exclusions with regard to being nominated to stand in some multiple issues, such as not being able to stand for both a regional council and for any constituent authority of the council (i.e. one cannot stand for the West Coast Regional Council, and for the Westland District Council, whether it be for Mayor or Council.

#### CANDIDATE PROFILE STATEMENT

- The profile statement must be no more than 150 words so it is imperative that you do not exceed this limit as your statement will be ended at exactly the 150<sup>th</sup> word. (Your name and affiliation does not count in this word limit.)
- It must state your principal place of residence and whether you are standing in any other election, although these words will not count in terms of the word limit. In the case of a DHB, the word limit does not include the conflict of interest statement.
- The use of bullet points will not be allowed; the text will be run together with semi-colons.
- There can be better use of grammar (commas, apostrophes, semi-colons, etc) than using words such as the, a, and, I am, etc
- The use of acronyms is advisable i.e. WCRC is counted as one word, West Coast Regional Council is four words.

IT WOULD BE WISER TO TYPE THE STATEMENT AS A 'WORD' DOCUMENT OR AS THE BODY OF AN E-MAIL AND SEND IT DIRECT TO THE ELECTORAL OFFICER AT <u>elections@greydc.govt.nz</u> SO THAT THERE IS NO NEED FOR RE-TYPING, AND THEREFORE AVOID ANY TYPING ERRORS.

The statement may include a **recent** photograph of the candidate **alone** which:

- should be approximately 50mm by 40mm (passport size)
- as a general guide, has been taken within 12 months of the nomination
- can be supplied electronically as a JPEG scanned at 300 dpi

IT WOULD BE IN YOUR INTEREST TO HAVE A PHOTOGRAPH TAKEN WITH A DIGITAL CAMERA AND E-MAILED DIRECTLY TO THE ELECTORAL OFFICER AT <u>elections@greydc.govt.nz</u> SO THAT THIS AVOIDS HAVING THE PHOTO SCANNED, AND MAYBE DISTORTED IN THE PROCESSING STAGES.
